General Information

Parade Date/Time: Saturday, July 1, 2023 @ 12:00pm

Registration Deadline: Monday, June 26, 2023

Due to the new weight restrictions on the Cherry St bridge we had to make some minor changes to the parade. Please see below for the changes.

Check-in/Staging Area: **NEW Location.** 205 E. Erie St (Woodville Pool) - there will be an information/check-in table (in front of the Boy Scout Building). **Please enter check-in from Cherry St.** Each unit must check-in beginning at 10:00am to receive a line up number as well as an escort to their starting location. Vehicles and floats are not to be moved once they have been placed in the staging area. Check-in will promptly close at 11:30; late arrivals will not be placed in parade line-up. Any one not registered prior to parade day will be placed at the end of the parade and will not be judged. **There will be limited parking at the pool. Please see map for additional parking areas.**

Parade Route: **NEW** The parade will step off at the corner of College and S. Perry Streets. Parade will proceed down College Avenue make a left onto Pemberville Road (St. Rte. 105) for one block and make another left onto Erie Street and proceed back towards the pool where it will be dispersed.

Judging Stand and Announcer: **NEW Location.** Please provide a brief narrative for the announcer to promote your school, organization, or business. The judges' stand/announcer will be located at Glittering Stars/Taylors Tae Kwon Do on College.
